Forklift Training Guidelines

It is important that all workplaces using forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness which can result in damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is access to forklift areas by pedestrians restricted by a barrier?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) The lift truck tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Are yearly checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the type of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted properly?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators acquired certification?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the equipment and other forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machinery being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed every day?
