There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machinery. Accidents can normally be caused from the improper utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, need to be utilized cautiously during loading, packing and unpacking.
